The City of Veneta will be accepting written comments concerning a temporary use permit to allow the establishment of a temporary retail BBQ food outlet operated from a van in the Southeast corner of Tax Lot 300 south of the existing espresso stand. The decision will be based on compliance with applicable criteria based upon information in the application and written comments received. Failure to raise an issue accompanied by statements or evidence sufficient to afford the parties an opportunity to respond to the issue precludes appeal to the City Council or LUBA based on that issue. The failure of the applicant to raise constitutional or other issues relating to proposed conditions of approval with sufficient specificity to allow a response to the issue precludes an action for damages in circuit court.
